An accredited conference must successfully meet the five criteria listed below:

- 1. Patients or caregivers with experience relevant to the conference's central theme actively participate in the design and planning of the event, including the selection of themes, topics and speakers.**

The program committee includes a parent from our Stollery Patient and Family Centered Care Council (PFCC) who actively participated in planning the conference including identification of the theme, topics, and speakers.

2. Patients or caregivers with experience of the issues addressed by the event participate in its delivery, and appear in its physical audience.

Two of the speakers for the conference are parents with experiences directly related to the topic. Two of the speakers are patients (teens) with experience directly related to the topic.

3. Travel and accommodation expenses for patients or carers participating in the advertised programme are paid in full, in advance. Scholarships are provided by the conference organisers to allow patients or carers affected by the relevant issues to attend as delegates.

In addition to covering the registration and meal costs for the speakers we are covering costs for four (4) patients/family members to attend the conference. We will use a lottery system to choose. We will advertise this to patients and families on the Stollery Patient and Family Centered Facebook page, and in the PFCC Primer Newsletter. As noted above, the conference meets our Hospitals' Patient and Family Centered Care requirements as designated by the logo.

4. The disability requirements of participants are accommodated. All applicable sessions, breakouts, ancillary meetings, and other programme elements are open to patient delegates.

The conference facility is within the hospital and will accommodate the disability requirements of participants.

5. Access for virtual participants is facilitated with free streaming video provided online wherever possible

We will facilitate access for virtual attendance via social media using the hashtag #StolleryConf18. Any materials and pictures available post conference will also be shared publically through social media.
